



Rules and Information

for The Hayfield Pro-LoCo (A celebration of place)

The Pro-LoCo is an art competition organised by the Hayfield Civic Trust to promote the countryside and the parish of Hayfield.

It is intended to encourage artists of all abilities and all ages to paint or draw a scene within the parish of Hayfield. Members of the public are then invited to cast votes for all categories on display.

The venue for registration, return of work and voting is at St Matthew's Church Hall, Hayfield.

1. Categories and Prizes:

- Seniors 19 years and over – 1st prize £250 (and becomes the property of Hayfield Parish Council), 2nd prize £100, 3rd prize £75 and a Best Local Artists prize of £45.
- School age categories - 5yrs and under, 6-9 yrs, 10-13 yrs, 14-16 yrs, 17-18 yrs. 1st, 2nd and 3rd places receive prizes of art equipment.

2. Registration of all canvasses or papers to commence at 8.30am

3. Registration to close at 11.00am

4. All canvasses and papers to be stamped by Hayfield Civic Trust at the registration desk

5. Artwork **not** to be signed

6. Paintings to be painted within the Parish of Hayfield

7. All works of art to be completed during the day of the competition

8. Artwork may be in the following media:

- Oils, water colours, pastels, mixed media
- Collage permitted for category 5yrs and under
- Digital images are **not** permitted

9. Registration Fees:

- Senior artists 19 years and over £2.00 **per entry**
- All school age categories (upto and including age 18) free

10. Completed artwork to be returned to the specified location **by 3.45pm.**

11. Viewing and voting by members of the public 4.00pm to 5.00pm.

12. The decision of the organisers shall be final.

13. Prize giving will take place in St Matthew's Church at approx. 5.30pm

14. The Senior First prize winning picture then becomes the property of the Parish of Hayfield.

15. No paintings for sale until after the prize giving

Hayfield is situated on the A624, 5 miles north of Chapel-en-le Frith and 5 miles south of Glossop.

Good car parking to the west of the A624 only 50 metres from Hayfield's St Matthew's Church.
