



INFORMATION & CONDITIONS

The Hayfield Pro Loco – Art Competition

Organised by Hayfield Civic Trust

The competition is organised by Hayfield Civic Trust to promote the parish of Hayfield. It is intended to encourage artists of all abilities and ages to capture the essence of Hayfield as seen on the day of the competition. The public choose their favourite picture from each category at the end of the afternoon and these votes are added together to decide 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in the Senior section and 1st and 2nd prizes in the Junior categories.

1. CATEGORIES and PRIZES

Seniors (26 years and over)

- 1st prize £250, (The winning picture remains the property of Hayfield Parish Council.)
- 2nd prize £100,
- 3rd prize £75

Local artist prize winner is a resident of the parish with the highest number of votes drawn from the Senior category – £50 prize and the pro loco silver salver.

There is a **Young Adult Artist** category for the age group 17-25 with a prize of £50.

Junior categories are: age 4 and under; 5 & 6 years; 7 & 8 years; 9 & 10 years; 11 & 12 years; 13 & 14 years; 15 & 16 years -1st and 2nd places in each category receive prizes of art materials

2. VENUE

The venue for registration, return of work and voting is St Matthew's Church & Hall, Hayfield

3. COMPETITION PROCEDURES

- Registration of all adult canvasses or papers commences at 8.30am
- Registration for adults closes at 11.00am
- All adult canvasses and papers to be stamped by Hayfield Civic Trust at the registration desk
- Artwork must **not** be signed
- All adult works of art to be completed in the parish during the day of the competition and capture the essence of Hayfield as seen on the day
- No canvassing is allowed during voting. Identifying the artist may result in disqualification of the painting.
- Artwork may be in the following media: oils, water colour, pastels, mixed media.
- Collage is permitted for 4yrs and under
- Children's artwork may be completed in the preceding week leading up to the day of the competition but must be of a scene in Hayfield during that week.
- All children's artwork must have a printed label on the back giving details of name, age and date of completion and returned to the Church hall between 8.30 – 11.00 am or 2.00 – 3.45 pm.
- Paper with the printed label on the back will be provided via the local primary school, nursery school and playgroup. This label may be removed and pasted on the back of another piece of paper if this is the preferred option. **You will also find a copy of the entry form at the bottom of page two.**
- If your child does not attend a school or nursery in Hayfield, you can request paper and or the label via the following email: info@hayfield-civic-trust.org.uk
- Digital images are **not** permitted

4. REGISTRATION FEES

- Senior artists £3.00 **per entry**
- Young Adult artists and Junior Arts – **free entry**

5. DISPLAY OF WORK AND VOTING

- Completed artwork to be returned to the specified location **by 3.45pm**
- Seniors may wish to frame their work – an area is provided for this activity
- Viewing and voting by members of the public 4.00pm to 5.00pm
- Canvassing for votes is not allowed. Identifying the artist may result in disqualification of the painting.
- The decision of the organisers shall be final.

6. PRIZE GIVING

- Prize giving will take place in St Matthew’s Church at approximately 5.30pm
- The Senior First prize winning picture becomes the property of the Parish of Hayfield and is hung in Hayfield Village Hall.
- No painting may be sold until after the prize giving

Hayfield is situated on the A624, 5 miles North of CHAPEL-EN-LE FRITH and 5 miles South of GLOSSOP. Good car parking to the West of the A624 only 50metres from Hayfield's St Matthew's Church.
